PROGRAM NOTE

Lucid Dream was written for a call for scores featuring the Odelya trio. It is based on a stress dream that I had in the summer of 2022. It explores the fear of being observed and lacking control over one's immediate environment. It also explores the division between inside and outside.

PERFORMANCE NOTES

Singer – The first two thirds of the piece are spoken. In which case all that is indicated is the relative duration that the line(s) of text should take up in relation to the other performers. This is a general guideline. This narration should be very matter of fact, much like the logic there is in a dream.

Piano – If you are unable to mute the upper strings with your L.H. (because of the construction of the piano) prepare the strings with a piece of cloth, or depress a practice pedal.
